Welcome to a new term at Bosley St. Mary's Primary School. We hope you've all had a wonderful summer.

I would just like to provide you with some important information regarding our return to school. We are excited at the prospect of a new year with fewer restrictions.

Following the new DFE Guidance we have made changes to our processes.

- Face coverings are no longer advised for the staff and/or visitors to school. Parents/Carers may wish to continue to wear them in the vicinity of school but there is no requirement to do so.
- Whilst social distancing in the work

place has now ceased, we still ask the wider community to continue social distancing with each other and with staff members.

- The school day will start at normal time from 8.45am. We ask parents and carers to move through the school grounds following the signs as last term.
- Please remember that should your child display symptoms of COVID-19: New persistent cough; high temperature or change or loss of taste or smell, they must stay at home and arrange a PCR test.
- Should your child show any other symptoms of illness please keep them at home until they are well enough to return to school.
- PE days - children to come to school in

their PE kits for the day. They should wear a white t-shirt with black or burgundy joggers, shorts or leggings. Jumpers should be school jumpers, no sportswear please.

- Forest School days - children should come dressed ready for their session.
- Collection time at the end of the day will be at 3.10pm for Blossom Class and 3.15pm for Willow and Oak Class. Our teaching team will be on the playground at the end of the day.

We are all looking forward to an exciting year ahead.

We are all so proud of the new reception children who have settled into their new class beautifully. What an incredible start to their very first term at primary school.

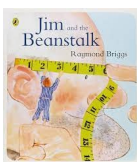
A huge thank you to the Year 1 children who have been so grown up, friendly and have supported the Reception children as they settled in life at Bosley School.

Mrs Hadfield has mentioned what an amazing class she has this year and has already been blown away by the children's enthusiasm for learning.



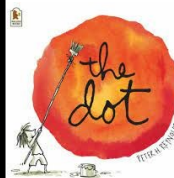
The children have started their new English topic, Jim and the Beanstalk which looks to have some great cross curricular links for thematic learning.
