Below are some of the exciting plans that we have for the Summer Term and beyond.

Aspiration at Bosley St Mary's

Of course, we are firm believers in encouraging the children to work hard and do their very best at school. Part of this process is to show them that they could have a really interesting career once they leave school. Therefore we will be having our second ‘**Aspiration Week**’ during the summer term.

During Aspiration Week we invite adults into school who have a range of interesting jobs to talk to the children about how they worked hard and overcame challenges in order to pursue their career. Hopefully these talks will inspire the children to believe that if they work hard at school then they could aspire to also following an interesting career path.

Following the success of the **Number Ninjas** – group of aspirational Year 5 and 6 mathematicians taught by Mr Barard we are planning to introduce a similar programme where we target children in Years 2, 3 and 4 who need an extra challenge in their learning.

Playground Development

We have plans to develop the playground which include:

- Creating a tarmac court in front of the school.
- Developing a sensory area where the children can play with sand, water and music.
- Having a new larger climbing frame built where the old pond was situated.
- Establishing a sensory garden where children can enjoy peace and quiet.
- Having new markings painted onto the tarmac sections of the playground.

These initiatives will be funded through the Sports Grant, the PTA and hopefully through grants that we are currently applying for.
