## All Age Worship

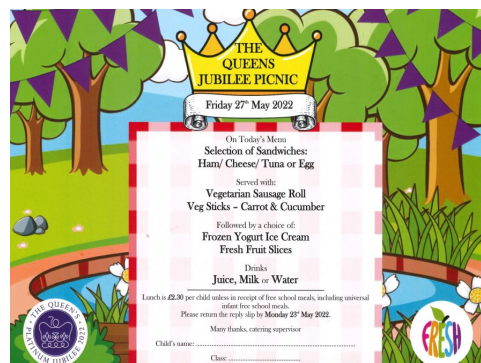
