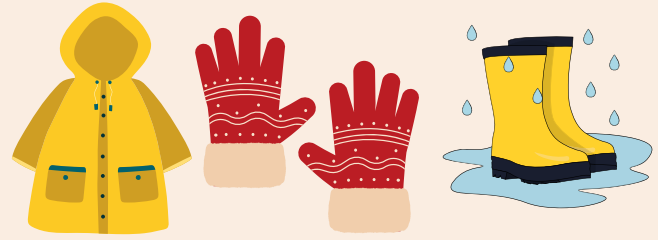


REMINDERS
