Our new Worship Leaders have quickly settled into their role by organising our Whole School Reflections.

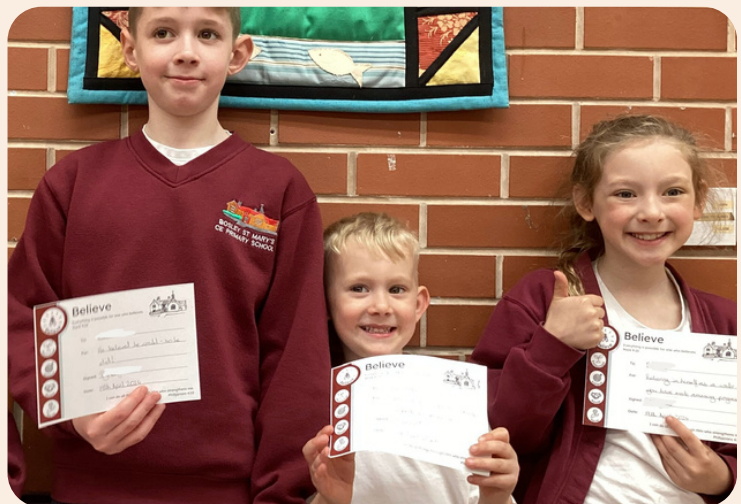

School doors open at 8:40

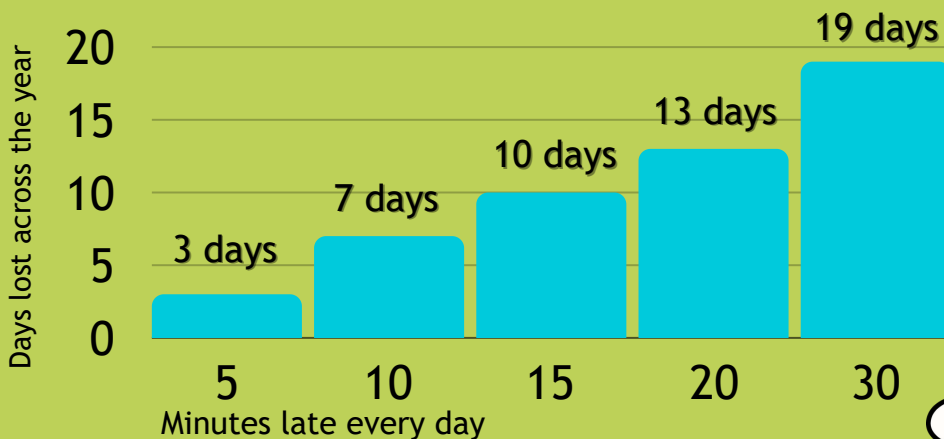
