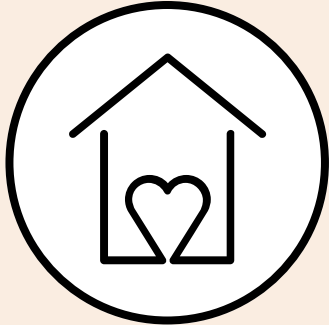

We are a charity working to help families enjoy learning together at home.

On your mobile phone, tablet or computer, you can log your child's reading by leaving comments, photos or audio clips. The class teacher then gets your feedback and photos so they can see how your child is getting on.

### How does it work?

- 1) You will receive an email or text from us every week with a weekly reading target.
- 2) Click on the link in the email to be taken to your child's reading log – no need for passwords!
- 3) Leave comments, photos, and audio clips of your child reading for your class teacher.

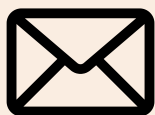
# Tax -Free Childcare

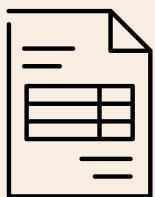

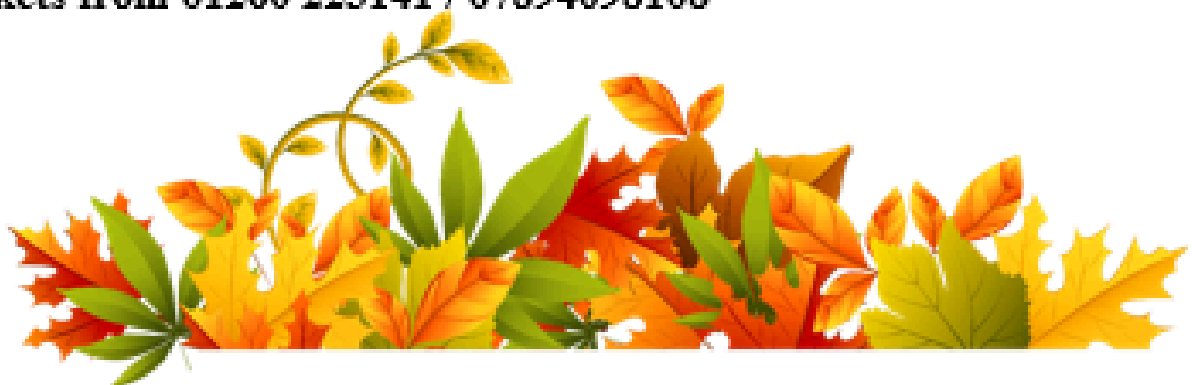
